ENGLISH	
1. Write Alphabet both in Capital (A to Z) as well as in Small (a – z) letters. (2 Times). 2. Write any 3 words from each alphabet.	1. Paste 5 pictures of “OO” words. 2. Using Toothpick, Ice Cream Stick, Matchstick etc, prepare designs of letters having straight line. e.g.: A, E, F, H etc.

MATHS

1. Write the number – 0 to 50.
2. Write the number names – 0 to 10.
3. Count the number of following things at your home – Wooden doors, windows, chairs, fans, mobile phones, bottles and buckets. Write them in numerals and their number names.
e.g. Wooden Doors = 8 (Eight)

1. Collect the pictures of your choice and paste the things **in order**. (Refer to Primary Maths Book. Pg. No. 14 – 16)
 - a) Begin with **shortest** object and write 1, 2, 3, 4.
 - b) Begin with **biggest** object and write 1, 2, 3, 4.
2. Paste a **Calendar** of the year **2021**. Colour the months having five Mondays in “**YELLOW**” and the months having five Thursdays in “**PINK**” colour.

1. Write names of 10 body parts (3 times) each.
2. Write names of the food that you generally eat or drink at your home.

1. Collect and paste three pictures of **healthy** and **unhealthy** food items and name them clearly.
2. Collect pictures of **advertisements** (From old newspaper, magazine etc.) related to various **sense organs** and paste them. (Two advertisements of each sense organ.)

HINDI (For Section A, B & C Only)

1. Write Hindi Alphabet (3 times).
2. Learn & write Hindi numbers from 1 – 10. (2 times)
3. Write any 2 words from the Hindi Alphabet (क - ज़) having “**Aa**” ki matra.

1. Collect **5 pictures** of body parts that begin with “**Aa**” ki matra, paste and label them.

1. Write Odia Alphabet (3 times).
2. Learn & write Odia numbers from 1 – 25. (3 times each)
